Essay Questions

- 1. Discuss the following argument. "Mental states, like being in pain, are private to the person experiencing them. So it is nonsense to say that I have a higher tolerance for pain than you, since that would require us to compare my pains and yours."
- 2. Discuss the following argument. "We have no idea what the needs and desires of future people will be. So it is impossible to specify what our responsibilities to these future people are. But if we cannot specify what our responsibilities to future people are, we have no moral responsibility towards them. Therefore, we have no moral responsibility towards future people."
